

Good locations?


- All Marinas in Guernsey & the Main Town Square, St Peter Port

 - Choose good physical aerial siting


Using Right Equipment

- Still using original RB532A's, some RB433AH's and a RB800 for Hotspots
- VMWare 4 hosting UM v5 in central data centre for AAA and PayPal payments
- All inter-connected using PPTP VPN for Radius (and OSPF for routing ensures it is easy to remotely maintain from central office)



RF Problems

Choosing the right location for AP!



Large metal objects – blocks and reflects RF signals



Tall metal masts – blocks and reflects RF signals



Siting aerial too low delivers poor signal levels to laptops



Siting aerial higher and with down-tilt allows obstructions to be avoided and resulting in higher Signal to Noise Ratios



Utilising a high gain 120 deg sectorial antenna with down-tilt allows the client to be received much better by the wireless card than mounting an omni on Harbour Master Office ©

Tx Power is minimised too, thus increasing life of the wireless card.

Low loss coax used, even at 2.4GHz

Use Scheduled Script to perform regular DNS lookups and insert A results found (via numerous CNAMEs) into Hotspot IP Walled Garden
